The Ulumbarra Foundation's Holsworth Creative Arts Bursary will provide financial support to students seeking assistance in developing their artistry and career in the creative arts.

An independent panel overseen by the Ulumbarra Foundation will review submissions and award a scholarship to those which demonstrate substantial positive impact for the applicant, through increased opportunity for creative advancement and career development.

Applicants in the current year (2023) must be enrolled in the Academy of Creative Arts at Bendigo South East College for the following year (2024) or undertaking a Creative Arts course in tertiary studies..

The total value of the scholarship pool is valued at, but not limited to, \$2000 and will be distributed between one or more applicants at the absolute discretion of the Ulumbarra Foundation.

Applications close at 3pm, 14 October 2023.

Applications will be acknowledged by email.

All applicants will be notified of the outcome as soon as possible.

Selection Process:

1. OVERVIEW OF THE ULUMBARRA FOUNDATION

The Ulumbarra Foundation was established in 2016 to support the Bendigo and central Victorian arts industry and participants. A key purpose of the charity is to raise awareness of and participation in performing arts programs, as well as for the development of regional artists.

2. STATEMENT OF REQUIREMENT

Eligible Applicants

Grants are available to students attending the Academy of Creative Arts, Bendigo South East College in 2022 and/or 2023 or undertaking a Creative Art course in tertiary studies.

Amount of Funds Available

A disbursement from the Holsworth Bursary of no less than \$2000 and no more than \$5000 will be distributed to eligible students and successful applicants to undertake specific activities within twelve months from the provision of grant monies.

Use of Funding

Grant funding may only be used to support expenses associated with those described in the application form. Funding will not be made available for/to non-related costs or retrospective expenses.

3. SELECTION CRITERIA & SELECTION PROCESS

Principle

The Ulumbarra Foundation's Holsworth Creative Arts Bursary will provide financial support to students seeking assistance in developing their artistry and career in the creative arts.

The overriding principle guiding the selection process is the value of positive impact for the applicant, through increased opportunity for creative advancement and career development.

Process

The process will be competitive selection process.

Selection Criteria

- Demonstration of how the proposal will be of benefit to the applicant
- Demonstration of applicant's excellence in the creative arts
- Clear outline of case for support and the impact of funding
- Consideration of supporting documentation

Stages in the Assessment Process

Applications will be assessed in accordance with the selection criteria and the assessment process below.

- Stage 1 - Receipt and registration of applications and initial screening for compliance and eligibility of applicants
- Stage 2 - Assessment against selection criteria and shortlist generated
- Stage 3 - Shortlisted applicants interviewed
- Stage 4 - Selection and notification of successful applicant/s.

The decision of the Board of the Ulumbarra Foundation is final.
